"When we refer children into the CAP program, Crisis Aid responds right away. I haven't seen any of the children we have referred into the CAP Program come back through the system. That's Success!"


That's an amazing testament to the power of this work and how needed it is.

PS: YOUR LIFE - CHANGING GIFT CAN HELP SAVE SOO MORE CHILDREN FROM A LIFE OF HORROR AND GIVE THEM A LIFE OF HOPE

Dear Loving Friend,

It's always in the eyes. The eyes tell the story of the soul.

Please used this letter from Cindy.

When I first looked into Aleysha's eyes, they were <u>lifeless</u>.

She looked like a cute little 13-year old girl, but she was sitting on the chair in front of me with **kkexixx** her shoulders hunched, body curled in to protect itself. She outright refused to admit that anything had been done to her - even though we had horrific video evidence of the terrible things she'd endured.

Things I won't describe to you, except to say it would break your heart knowing Aleysha was treated that way. In a way no child should ever be treated.

It took time and patience, but eventually, Aleysha did speak to me about what had happened to her. <u>That was the first</u> <u>step</u>.

Now, I'm not going to tell you it was an easy road; there were many ups and downs as we worked with her. But I recently received a photo from Aleysha's aunt. She was dressed in a fancy prom dress, smiling from ear to ear. Can I tell you... it sparked so much joy in my heart!

And her eyes? They were filled WXYK with life!

It was a long road that started with a first, challenging step. That step could not have happened without you.

Through your amazing support of Crisis Aid International, you gave Aleysha the support she needed to open up about what was happening to her. I'm so grateful I had the honor to be there for Alysha, through the Child's Anti-Exploitation (CAP) Program, to give her that trusted space.

You had a hand in all the steps that came after that, too.

As a Crisis Aid employee working in partnership with the police, I was able to be there (and so were you!) to support Aleysha along the way. We (YOU and I) were able to walk alongside Aleysha as she slowly began to see the police department as a **safe place to go for help**. We stayed with Aleysha and her new family as they navigated the criminal justice process. We **held her hand as she bravely stood up** to be a part of the prosecution of her abusers - the people she no longer called family. Aleysha moved in with her aunt and uncle to help create a more stable home environment. You and I guided them through a plan where Aleysha could be comfortable receiving mental health counseling and support.

There were certainly roadblocks along the way.

Aleysha had lived in a world without structure, a world of complete and utter neglect. She now lived in a stable home with proper boundaries and rules - which was a lot to get used to at first! But with support, her aunt and uncle stuck it out, and Aleysha began to respect the boundaries she was living with.

At first, I would see Aleysha almost every week. Now, we check in around major events or milestones, like prom or graduation. I love seeing those photos that show her living the kind of life a girl her age *should* be living! She even made all A's and B's on her most recent report card. I remember when her aunt called me. She **week** was so excited! I could just see Aleysha beaming from ear-to-ear through her words. I am so <u>incredibly proud of her</u>. She has shown amazing strength and resilience through all of this.

That is what you have done for Aleysha. Thank you!

Together, you and I helped her take the first step towards a new life filled with hope and possibility rather than one filled with pain and fear, and horror.

Thank you for helping to put the spark of life back into Aleysha's eyes! Thank you for reaching out your hand and showing her that the compassionate love of God can heal all wounds, given time and space to do so.
